Job Description: The Family Support Worker applies trauma informed practice in every aspect of their position. They provide a range of parenting support services to women and their children at the Ksan Transition House. The position focuses on building on family strengths, encouraging positive parent-child relationships, and promoting the safety and well-being of the children within the family. The FSW collaborates with Ksan Society staff and other child, youth, and family focussed community agencies to assist in providing a seamless service for care. The position requires a strong woman-centered understanding of the impact of violence experienced by women and children.

Qualifications: Bachelor's degree in related human/social service field plus one (1) year recent related experience, OR an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience. Preference will be given to candidates who possess formal Early Childhood Education.
